RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 276377 ADOPTED ON AUG 7 1990

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REQUESTING THE CONSOLIDATION OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON NOVEMBER 6, 1990, WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION.

WHEREAS, at the meeting of the City Council held on
August 7, 1990, the Council indicated its intention to submit to
the qualified voters of The City of San Diego, one proposition
relating to incurring bonded indebtedness for the purpose of
requiring open space and park facilities, various propositions
amending the San Diego City Charter, one proposition relating to
an initiative measure adopting an amendment to The City of San
Diego Progress Guide and General Plan pertaining to traffic
control and growth management, and one proposition relating to an
advisory vote on financing of library construction and
maintenance costs at a special municipal election to be held in
the City on November 6, 1990; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that this special municipal election be consolidated with the statewide general election to be held on the same date and that within The City of San Diego the election precincts, polling places, voting booths and election officials for the two elections be the same, and that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego be authorized to canvass the returns of the special municipal election and that

this special municipal election and the statewide general election be held in all respects as if there were only one election; and

WHEREAS, this Council within the time required by law has adopted an ordinance calling for a special municipal election and consolidating it with the statewide primary election; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby requested to consolidate the special municipal election to be held in The City of San Diego on November 6, 1990, with the statewide general election to be held on the same date, for the purpose of amending the Charter of The City of San Diego.
- 2. The exact form of the propositions to be voted upon at this special municipal election and as they are to appear on the ballot is as follows:

- 3. That the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of this special municipal election and is requested to conduct the elections in all respects as if there were only one election using only one form of ballot.
- 4. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is requested to issue to all officers of the County charged with duties pertaining to the statewide general election appropriate instructions to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of a consolidated election.
- 5. That the City Clerk of The City of San Diego is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County of San Diego shall be reimbursed in full for the services performed by the Registrar of Voters for The City of San Diego in connection with the election services herein described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego agrees to indemnify and to save free and harmless the County, its officers, agents and employees from expense or liability, including

reasonable attorneys fees, as the result of an election contest initiated pursuant to the provisions of Division 13 of the Elections Code of the State of California after conduct of these elections.
