Exhibit "A" Mitigation and Monitoring Program Robinhood Creek (89-0414)

As a condition of Tentative Map No. 89-0414, evidence of annexation of the project site into Sweetwater Union High School District's Community Facilities District No. 5 shall be provided to the Planning Department prior to Final Map approval.

As a condition of Planned Residential Development (PRD) Permit No. 89-0414, a 5-foot high solid masonry noise attenuation wall shall be constructed along the east side of Smythe Avenue and along the south side of the I-905 on-ramp along the project property line. Evidence of the wall construction shall be provided to the Principal Planner of the Environmental Analysis Section prior to the issuance of building permits.

As a condition of PRD Permit No. 89-0404, construction plans shall be reviewed and approved by the City Noise Abatement Administrator and the Principal Planner of the Environmental Analysis Section to assure installation of measures to reduce interior noise levels to 45 dB(A) CNEL.
