. MITIGATING MEASURES AND MONITORING PROGRAM:

Erosion control measures include the installation of grease interceptors and suspension of grading during periods of inclement weather. Installation of the grease interceptors will be made a condition of the grading permit and will be inspected by the Engineering and Development Department prior to acceptance of the grading.

A noise wall is proposed to mitigate noise impacts. The wall will be made a condition of the building permit, and will be inspected by the Building Inspection Department prior to issuance of occupancy permits. An acoustical analysis for interior noise levels will be required prior to issuance of building permits for units adjacent to El Camino Real.

The development plan permit will restrict future development of the 6.0-acre "remainder parcel" to an amount not to exceed 0.5 acres of disturbance or adequate mitigation to ensure that impacts to biological resources would not be significant. (See discussion of Biology in Section V of the Initial Study.)
