RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, MAKING APPOINTMENTS AND APPROVING AGREEMENTS IN SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT PROCEEDINGS.

(Assessment District No. 4055 [Camino Del Rio South])

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego, California is considering the formation of a special assessment district, said proceedings to be conducted substantially pursuant to the provisions of the "Municipal Improvement Act of 1913," being Division 12 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, except where expressly modified or amended by the provisions of the San Diego Improvement District Procedural Ordinance of 1982, for the construction and/or acquisition of certain public works of improvement, together with appurtenances and appurtenant work, said special assessment district known and designated as ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 4055 (CAMINO DEL RIO SOUTH) (hereinafter referred to as the "Assessment District"); and

WHEREAS, at this time this Council is desirous of making the required appointments and designating persons to perform certain duties in order to allow the proceedings to go forward to completion in accordance with the provisions of law; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the above recitals are all true and correct.

- 2. That JOSEPH A. FRANCISCO is hereby appointed to perform all of the duties and functions of the Superintendent of Streets as said duties are specified and designated in the "Municipal Improvement Act of 1913," being Division 12 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, for the above-referenced Assessment District.
- 3. That the place for recordation of the assessment roll and diagram shall be in the office of the Superintendent of Streets, and said assessment roll and diagram, upon recordation, shall be kept as a permanent record.
- 4. That the DAILY TRANSCRIPT is hereby designated as the newspaper for all publications as required by law and as necessary for completion of this Assessment District.
- 5. That the Council does hereby appoint KADIE-JENSEN,

 JOHNSON & BODNAR as the Assessment Engineer for said proceedings,
 and that the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and
 empowered to execute, for and on behalf of said City, an
 agreement with KADIE-JENSEN, JOHNSON & BODNAR, for Assessment
 Engineering services and shall perform all of the duties and
 responsibilities as set forth by law as they relate to said
 Assessment District, under the terms and conditions set forth in
 the Agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document
 No.
- 6. That this Council hereby establishes a special Improvement Fund designated by the name and number of the Assessment District, and into said fund shall be placed all proceeds from the sale of bonds and cash collections. In order

to expedite the improvements or acquisition under these proceedings and as authorized by law, funds from any available source may be transferred into said special fund. Any funds transferred are a loan to the fund and shall be repaid out of the proceeds of the sale of bonds, all as required and authorized by law, and specifically Section 10210 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California.
