WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego held a public hearing on October 4, 1990, to consider whether to initiate an amendment to the Mira Mesa Community Plan for the Wateridge Residential Project meets the initiation criteria of Council Policy 600-35, Processing of Community Plan Amendments; and

WHEREAS, Scripps Wateridge Associates has requested this community plan amendment to change the land use designation on an 18.11 acre site at the southwest corner of Lusk Boulevard and Wateridge Circle from Industrial Park and Open Space to a land use designation that would allow the development of an apartment/sports complex; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission recommended approval by the City Council of said initiation request; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council hereby initiates an amendment to the Mira Mesa Community Plan for Wateridge Residential Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this amendment proposal is exempt from Council Policy 600-35, Section C.2c which states that a hearing to amend a community plan shall not be scheduled less than six months prior to an anticipated Planning Commission

hearing on a community plan update, and from the annual public hearing process established in Council Policy 600-35.
