BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of said City, hereby proclaims Saturday, November 17, 1990 as "Friends of Los

Penasquitos Canyon Preserve" Day in recognition of the organization's considerable contributions to the City of San Diego, and hereby expresses its appreciation to the membership for their continuing dedication and commitment to public education and resource protection.
