AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING VARIOUS PROPERTIES IN THE PACIFIC BEACH COMMUNITY PLANNING AREA TO COMPLY WITH THE SINGLE FAMILY NEIGHBORHOOD CLASSIFICATION MAP FOR PACIFIC BEACH, LOCATED IN AN AREA GENERALLY TO THE WEST OF INTERSTATE 5, AND TO THE NORTH OF MISSION BAY, AND TO THE EAST OF THE PACIFIC OCEAN, AND TO THE SOUTH OF THE LA JOLLA COMMUNITY, IN THE PACIFIC BEACH COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, INTO THE R-3000 ZONE AS DEFINED BY SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 101.0410, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NOS. 0-10891 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED AUGUST 16, 1972, AND 0-17159 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED OCTOBER 11, 1988, OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO INSOFAR AS THE SAME CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That various properties in the Pacific Beach Community Planning area to comply with the implementation of the Single Family Neighborhood Protection program in the Pacific Beach Community Plan area, located in an area generally to the west of Interstate 5, and to the north of Mission Bay, and to the east of the Pacific Ocean, and to the south of the La Jolla Community, in the Pacific Beach Community Plan area, in the City of San Diego, California, within the boundary of the areas designated "R-3000" on Zone Map Drawing No. C-829.2, filed in the

office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00-_____,
be, and they are hereby incorporated into the R-3000 Zone, as
such zone is described and defined by San Diego Municipal Code
section 101.0410.

Section 2. That Ordinance Nos. 0-10891 (New Series), adopted August 16, 1972, and 0-17159 (New Series), adopted October 9, 1988, of the ordinances of the City of San Diego be and they are repealed insofar as the same conflict herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage, however, the provisions of this ordinance shall not be applicable within the Coastal Zone until the thirtieth day following the date the California Coastal Commission unconditionally certifies this ordinance as a local coastal program amendment. If this ordinance is not certified, or is certified with suggested modifications by the California Coastal Commission, the provisions of this ordinance shall be null and void within the Coastal Zone.

Section 4. In areas of Pacific Beach other than the Coastal Zone, no permits for development inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be issued unless application therefore was made prior to November 20, 1990.

Section 5. Within the Coastal Zone, no permits for development inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be issued unless application therefor was made prior to November 20, 1990.




