AN ORDINANCE CALLING A RECALL ELECTION IN
COUNCIL DISTRICT FIVE (5) ON TUESDAY, APRIL
9, 1991.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as
follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordered that a Recall Election will
be held in Council District Five (5) on Tuesday, April 9, 1991,
for the purpose of submitting to the voters of District Five (5)
the proposal to recall Councilmember Linda Bernhardt, and, if
said Councilmember is recalled, to elect a successor.

Section 2. For the purpose of said election, the boundaries
for District Five (5) shall be those boundaries as they existed
on November 24, 1990.

Section 3. For the purpose of said election, the election
precincts shall be the precincts established by the Board of
Supervisors of the County of San Diego; provided, however, that
certain said precincts shall be consolidated in the manner
indicated on the list of consolidated precincts on file in the
office of the City Clerk.

Section 4. The City Clerk shall designate the polling
places, and shall appoint the members of the precinct boards for
said election.

Section 5. That the polls for said election shall be open
from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, April 9, 1991.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to procure and supply the required number of ballots, sample ballots, equipment, supplies and other printed matter.

Section 7. The following rates of compensation are hereby established for said election:

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:
Section 1. It is hereby ordered that a Recall Election will be held in Council District Five (5) on Tuesday, April 9, 1991, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of District Five (5) the proposal to recall Councilmember Linda Bernhardt, and, if said Councilmember is recalled, to elect a successor.
Section 2. For the purpose of said election, the boundaries for District Five (5) shall be those boundaries as they existed on November 24, 1990.
Section 3. For the purpose of said election, the election precincts shall be the precincts established by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego; provided, however, that certain said precincts shall be consolidated in the manner indicated on the list of consolidated precincts on file in the office of the City Clerk.
Section 4. The City Clerk shall designate the polling places, and shall appoint the members of the precinct boards for said election.
Section 5. That the polls for said election shall be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, April 9, 1991.
