AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 2,
DIVISION 2, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE
BY AMENDING SECTION 102.0201 RELATING TO THE
ORDINANCES, POLICIES AND STANDARDS TO BE
APPLIED TO TENTATIVE MAPS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 2, Division 2, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 102.0201, to read as follows:

SEC. 102.0201 TENTATIVE MAPS

The map and site plan shall comply with all ordinances, policies and standards in effect at the date the Planning Department has determined that the application is complete pursuant to Section 65943 of the California Government Code, including, but not limited to the Progress Guide and General Plan incorporating "Guidelines for Future Development" (approved by the City Council on February 26, 1979), the applicable community plan and Council Policy No. 600-10, "Adequacy of Public Services in Connection with Development Proposals," Council Policy No. 600-28,

"Requirements for Development Approval in Planned Urbanizing Areas," Council Policy No. 600-36, "Requirements for Annual Adjustment of Facilities Benefit Assessments and Prepayment of Assessments," Resolution No. R-269095 dated August 7, 1987, and the Interim Development Ordinance adopted by the City Council on July 21, 1987, and any successor ordinance, plan or policy imposing the same or similar requirements.


