ORDINANCE NUMBER O-17593 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON JAN 28 1991

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 6, DIVISION 7, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 26.0701 AND 26.0703 RELATING TO THE DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE COMMISSION FOR ARTS AND CULTURE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 6, Division 7, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Sections 26.0701 and 26.0703 to read as follows:

**SECTION 26.0701**

It is the purpose and intent of the City Council to establish a Commission for Arts and Culture to serve in an advisory capacity to the Mayor, City Council and City Manager on promoting, encouraging and increasing support for the arts.

It shall be the responsibility of the Commission for Arts and Culture to make all recommendations for City funding pertaining to arts and culture to the City Council using objective criteria and evaluation panels, as appropriate.

It shall be the responsibility of the Commission for Arts and Culture to serve in an advisory capacity to the Mayor, City Council and City Manager on projects and programs designed to promote the arts in public places throughout the neighborhoods of The City of San Diego, and encourage the private sector to include the arts in private developments.

**SECTION 26.0703 DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS**

The Commission for Arts and Culture shall:


B. Make all funding recommendations directly to the Mayor,

This ordinance amends the Municipal Code to require the Commission for Arts and Culture to make all of its funding recommendations directly to the Mayor, City Council and City Manager, rather than make its recommendations to a workshop comprised of the Committee of the Whole, and subsequently to the Public Services and Safety Committee, as is currently required. This ordinance also clarifies that the commission makes recommendations regarding allocation of City funds for the arts, and does not make recommendations regarding City grants for the arts, as is currently stated in the Municipal Code.


