AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 0-17468 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1990-91" TO CREATE THE NEW POSITION OF DISABLED SERVICES COORDINATOR; EXEMPTING SAID NEW POSITION FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; AMENDING EXHIBIT "C" TO SAID ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE SAID POSITION IN MANAGERIAL CATEGORY B; AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, on January 9, 1991, the City Council authorized the establishment of a new position of Disabled Services Coordinator, to be funded out of the General Fund Unallocated Reserve; and

WHEREAS, the Disabled Services Coordinator will plan, organize, coordinate, and participate in initiatives and strategies designed to assist persons with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, specific duties and responsibilities will include, but not be limited to maintaining liaison and coordination with City departments, other governmental agencies, private sector developers, local employers, school districts, and other interested organizations and individuals for the purpose of facilitating the disabled services program within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager is requesting that the position be established in the unclassified service and assigned to the Community Services Program; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission has reviewed the justification for the position on February 7, 1991 and has commented favorably thereon; and -PAGE 1 OF 3-

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the annual salary ordinance to create said position if Council should deem it appropriate and establish an appropriate rate of compensation therefor; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-17468 (NEW SERIES), as amended entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1990-91" be and the same is hereby further amended by creating and establishing the position of DISABLED SERVICES COORDINATOR.

Section 2. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City
Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably
by the Civil Service Commission on February 7, 1991 as meeting
the Charter criterion for exemption from the classified service,
and after having considered and reviewed the report thereon from
the Civil Service Commission, attached hereto as Attachment A,
the Council deems exemption appropriate and the position created
in section 1 above be and the same is hereby exempted from the
classified service and declared to be in the unclassified service
of The City of San Diego.

Section 3. That said Ordinance No. 0-17468 (NEW SERIES) be and it is hereby further amended to amend Exhibit C thereto so as to reflect said position designation of DISABLED SERVICES COORDINATOR in Managerial Category B.

Section 4. As a schedule of compensation for the position established and enumerated in sections 1 and 2 above, the position of DISABLED SERVICES COORDINATOR is hereby authorized and at salary ranges of 07.3, 07.4, 07.5, and 07.6.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

Exemption of a New Disabled Services Coordinator Position from

the Classified Service

On February 7, 1991, the Civil Service Commission reviewed a request from the Manager's Office to exempt a New Disabled Services Coordinator position from the Classified Service.

Charter Section 117 states that the Unclassified Service shall include "Managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council."

Upon review of the duties and responsibilities performed, the Commission finds that this position meets the criteria of the Charter and supports exemption from the Classified Service. If additional information would be of assistance in your consideration of this matter, staff is available to respond with details as necessary.
