On June 24, 1991, the City Council of The City of San Diego (the "City") approved Ordinance No. 0-17839 (New Series) which authorizes the proposed form and execution of certain agreements relating to the issuance of approximately \$12,500,000 of Certificates of Participation by the City for a term not to exceed thirty years. The Certificates of Participation ("Series 1991 Certificates" or "Certificates") are being issued in connection with proposed public improvements in Balboa Park and Mission Bay Park (the "Balboa Park and Mission Bay Park Capital improvements Pro-

Park (the "Balboa Fark and Mission Day Fain Capital improvements."

The City has proposed that the San Diego Facilities and Equipment Leasing Corporation (the "Corporation"), a nonprofit public benefit corporation, assist the City in the financing of the acquisition, construction and installation of a portion of the public improvements proposed in Balboa Park and Mission Bay Park, which portion financed by the Series 1991 Certificates shall constitute the "Project."

The ordinance authorizes the proposed form of a Site and Facilities

The ordinance authorizes the proposed form of a Facilities Lease (Document No. OO-17639-2), dated as of July 15, 1991, by and between the City and the Corporation and make certain lease payments for a term not to exceed thirty years. As a financing mechanism, the Certificates will be issued and delivered by the City evidencing the proportionate interests of the owners thereof in the lease payments to be made by the City to Corporation under the Facilities Lease.

The ordinance authorizes the proposed form of an Asaignment Agreement (Document No. OO-17639-4), dated as of July 15, 1991, by and between the Corporation and Bank of America National Trust & Savings Association, as Trustee (the "Trustee") in which the Corporation will assign all of its right to receive lease payments from the City to the Trustee for the purpose of paying the interest Components and Principal Components on the Certificates.
