ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 17645 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON MAY 20 1991

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING AND ESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARY LINES OF THE DISTRICTS WITHIN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 17539 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED OCTOBER 15, 1990.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That boundary lines of the eight districts of The City of San Diego, for the purpose of electing members of the Council, are hereby established, as more particularly shown and delineated on a map showing boundary lines of the districts on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00-17645, which is, by this reference, fully incorporated in and made a part of this ordinance.

Section 2. The offices of the Council members elected from even-numbered councilmanic districts shall be regularly up for election every four years commencing in 1991. The offices of Council members elected from odd-numbered councilmanic districts shall be regularly up for election every four years commencing in 1993.

Section 3. That Ordinance No. 17539 (New Series), adopted October 15, 1990, is hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.


