AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-17504 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1990-91 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. OO-17504-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY AMENDING THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION OF COUNCIL DISTRICT 3 (023) BY EXEMPTING ONE (1.00) COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVE I POSITION FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE, AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, Council District 3 has Council Representative positions presently authorized in its personnel allocation; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Council District 3 to job share one (1.00) such position so that the hours worked are split approximately 60 percent and 40 percent; and

WHEREAS, the position to be job shared is presently exempt from the classified service; and

WHEREAS, it has been requested that the additional part-time Council Representative position be exempted from the classified service and placed in the unclassified service; and

WHEREAS, section 117(a)17 of the Charter provides that "managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs" may be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance upon first having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission reviewed this request on June 20, 1991 and has commented favorably upon the exemption as meeting the criteria set forth in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the annual appropriation ordinance to effectuate said reclassification; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably by the Civil Service Commission in its memorandum to the City Council, dated June 21, 1991, attached hereto as Attachment A, the part-time Council Representative I position in Council District 3 (023) for fiscal year 1990-91 is hereby exempted from the classified service and declared to be in the unclassified service of The City of San Diego.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. O-17504 (NEW SERIES), as amended entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1990-91 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-17504-1, as adopted and amended therein, by amending the personnel authorization schedule for Council District 3 (023) to reflect therein the part-time Council Representative I position as being in the unclassified service.

Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for the above unclassified position created in sections 1 and 2 hereof, the

salary rate set forth in Salary Rates 7.0, 7.1 and 7.2 of the Table of Classifications and Standard Salary Rates under Managerial Category A, contained in Exhibit C to Ordinance No. 0-17643 (NEW SERIES), be and the same is hereby adopted.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage after two (2) public hearings pursuant to the authority contained in sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.

SUBJECT:

Exemption of a Council Representative I & II Position from the

Classified Service

On June 20, 1991, the Civil Service Commission reviewed a request from District 3 to review and comment on the exemption of part-time Council Representative position from the Classified Service. This will allow the District to hire two part-time employees on a job share basis to fill one previously exempted full time Council Representative position.

Charter Section 117 states that the Unclassified Service shall include "managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating and administering department policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempt from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council."


Upon review of the administrative and managerial duties and responsibilities of this position, staff finds that this position meets the intent of Charter Section 117. In addition, the proposed duties of this position are comparable to those of other Council Representative positions which have been exempted from the Classified Service. It is therefore recommended that this request be approved.
