ADOPTED ON JUL 22 1991

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 1991.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordered that a General Municipal Election will be held in the City of San Diego on Tuesday, November 5, 1991, for the purpose of electing candidates for the following offices, unless such candidates have been elected in the Municipal Primary Election:

COUNCILMEMBER for District No. 2	four-year term
COUNCILMEMBER for District No. 4	four-year term
COUNCILMEMBER for District No. 6	four-year term
COUNCILMEMBER for District No. 8	four-year term

Section 2. For the purpose of said election, the election precincts shall be the precincts established by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego; provided, however, that certain said precincts shall be consolidated in the manner indicated on the list of consolidated precincts on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall designate the polling places, and shall appoint the members of the precinct boards for said election.

Section 4. That the polls for said election shall be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, November 5, 1991.

Section 5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to procure and supply the required number of ballots, sample ballots, equipment, supplies and other printed matter.

Section 6. The following rates of compensation are hereby established for said election:

Inspectors	\$50.00*
Judges	\$35.00
Clerks	\$35.00
Rental of Polling Place	\$25.00

*Compensation provides for ballot box returns.

Section 7. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be published once in the official newspaper of The City of San Diego.

Section 8. Pursuant to Section 17 of the Charter of The City of San Diego, this ordinance shall take effect on the date of its adoption.



This ordinance adopts the annual appropriation ordinance for The City of San Diego for fiscal year 1991-92. It appropriates and allocates the necessary money to operate the City for said fiscal year and provides for the various internal, enterprise and special funds and departments of the City. It also makes appropriate and necessary provision for transfer of funds by the Auditor and Comptroller when directed by the Financial Management Department and further provides for crediting of revenues and interest earnings to various specified funds. Finally, the ordinance authorizes and allocates funds for Capital Improvement Program projects.


