AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 4, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 101.0407 AND SECTION 101.0410 RELATING TO A TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF THE ENFORCEMENT OF REGULATIONS AFFECTING PARKING, STORAGE AND SCREENING OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIAL ZONES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 4, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 101.0407, to read as follows:

101.0407 R-1 Zones

101.0407A-E - NO CHANGE

101.0407F OUTDOOR STORAGE AND PLACEMENT

101.0407F.1-5 - NO CHANGE

6. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF THE ENFORCEMENT OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLE REGULATIONS

(a) Declaration and Purpose - Pursuant to Resolution R- 278394, the City Council directed the Planning Director to conduct a comprehensive re-evaluation of the Municipal Code as it pertains to regulating parking, storage and screening of recreational vehicles in residential zones. During this period of re-evaluation the Council deems it desirable to suspend enforcement of those provisions of the Municipal Code regulating parking, storage and screening of

recreational vehicles in residential zones as set forth in San Diego Municipal Code sections 101.0407F and 101.0410(O).

(b) Conditions of the temporary suspension: The City Council hereby declares that all regulations contained in San Diego Municipal Code Section 101.0407 which pertain to the parking, storage and screening of recreational vehicles in single-family residential zones shall not be enforced for a period of six months from [SEP 04 1991 the effective date of this ordinance].

(c) For purposes of this temporary suspension, "suspension of enforcement," means that no new notices of violation may be issued and all pending investigations, administrative actions or court actions shall be postponed during the suspension period.

(d) Nothing in San Diego Municipal Code section 101.0407F.6 shall be interpreted to preclude the City from proceeding after conclusion of the suspension period with pending investigations, administrative actions or court actions.

(e) Exception: During the effective period of this temporary suspension the Planning Director shall continue to enforce any provision of the Municipal Code regulating the parking, storage and screening of recreational vehicles in residential zones, if, in the discretion of the Planning Director, the violation is deemed to constitute a safety hazard.

Section 2. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 4, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 101.0410, to read as follows:

101.0410 R Zones (Multiple Family Residential)

101.0410A-N - NO CHANGE

101.0410(O) STORAGE AND PLACEMENT

101.0410(O)2.a-e - NO CHANGE

f. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF THE ENFORCEMENT OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLE REGULATIONS

1) Declaration and Purpose - Pursuant to Resolution R-278394, the City Council directed the Planning Director to conduct a comprehensive re-evaluation of the Municipal Code as it pertains to regulating parking, storage and screening of recreational vehicles in residential zones. During this period of re-evaluation the Council deems it desirable to suspend enforcement of those provisions of the Municipal Code regulating parking, storage and screening of recreational vehicles in residential zones as set forth in San Diego Municipal Code sections 101.0407.F and 101.0410(O).

2) Conditions of the temporary suspension: The City Council hereby declares that all regulations contained in San Diego Municipal Code section 101.0410 which pertain to the parking, storage and screening of recreational vehicles in R (Multiple Family Residential) zones shall not be enforced for a period of six months from [SEP 04 1991].

3) For purposes of this temporary suspension, "suspension of enforcement," means that no new notices of violation may be issued and all pending investigations, administrative actions or court actions shall be postponed during the suspension period.

4) Nothing in San Diego Municipal Code section 101.0410(0)2.f shall be interpreted to preclude the City from proceeding after conclusion of the suspension period with pending investigations, administrative actions or court actions.


5) Exception: During the effective period of this temporary suspension the Planning Director shall continue to enforce any provision of the Municipal Code regulating parking, storage and screening of recreational vehicles in residential zones, if, in the discretion of the Planning Director, the violation is deemed to constitute a safety hazard.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby instructed to insert the effective date of this ordinance in place of the brackets appearing in the amended portions of Sections 101.0407F and 101.0410(0).

Section 4. The City Clerk is hereby instructed to remove Sections 101.0407F.6 and 101.0410(0)2.f from the San Diego Municipal Code as soon as possible after the six calendar months has passed from the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 4, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 101.0407 AND SECTION 101.0410 RELATING TO A TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF THE ENFORCEMENT OF REGULATIONS AFFECTING STORAGE AND PARKING OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIAL ZONES.

This ordinance amends the San Diego Municipal Code by adding section 101.0407F.6 and section 101.0410(O)2.f. relating to the parking, storage and screening of recreational vehicles in single-family and multi-family residential zones.

San Diego Municipal Code sections 101.0407F.6.b (pertaining to single-family zones) and 101.0410(O)2.f.2 (pertaining to the multi-family zones) are added to declare a temporary suspension for a period not to exceed six (6) months of the enforcement of recreational vehicle parking and storage regulations to go into effect on the effective date of this Ordinance.

The amendments define "suspension of enforcement." They also authorize the Planning Director to continue to enforce any provision of the Municipal Code regulating parking and storage of recreational vehicles in residential zones during the suspension period, if, in the discretion of the Planning Director, the violation is deemed to constitute a safety hazard.
