ADOPTED ON

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 0-17648 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR FISCAL YEAR 1991-92" BY ADDING A NEW SECTION 5.1, ENTITLED "FLSA EXEMPT EMPLOYEE SALARY STATUS."

WHEREAS, the City has attempted to fully comply with the Fair Labor Standards Act; and

WHEREAS, recent court decisions have materially affected interpretation of the Fair Labor Standards Act relating to exempt employees; and

WHEREAS, the City may have unintentionally and inadvertently been noncompliant with the Act in respect to certain employees; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to revise the City's compensation policies with the express intent to comply fully with said judicial interpretations of the Fair Labor Standards Act; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has discussed these revisions with affected employee organizations during the meet and confer process in an attempt to reach agreement and is therefore recommended for adoption by the Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-17648 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF

COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR FISCAL YEAR 1991-92" be and the same is hereby amended by adding a new section 5.1, entitled "FLSA EXEMPT EMPLOYEE SALARY STATUS" to read as follows:

SECTION 5.1 FLSA EXEMPT EMPLOYEE SALARY STATUS

• • • • •

Not withstanding any other provisions of this ordinance, the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby expressly authorized to compensate all employees who are designated as exempt under and from the provisions of the Fair Labor Standards Act, in recognition of their salaried status, for absences of less than a full work day, in the event such employees do not have sufficient paid leave credits to cover the period of such absence. Such compensation shall be deemed not to constitute a gift of public funds but rather a recognition by Council of the salaried status of designated employees.

The express intent of this provision is to fully comply with the salary status requirements of the Fair Labor Standards Act as interpreted by the courts. Should the Fair Labor Standards Act be amended or reinterpreted by the courts to cause this provision to be noncompliant with the salary

exemption requirements of the Act, or exceed the requirements of the Act, in that event the City Manager, in conjunction with the Personnel Director and the Auditor and Comptroller, shall be and is hereby authorized to take whatever actions are legally required and necessary to implement further revisions to the City's compensation policies which are in full compliance with the Act and in the best interest of The City of San Diego.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
