AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 0-17667 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1991-92 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION OF THE WASTE MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT (752) TO EXEMPT A NEW ASSISTANT DEPUTY DIRECTOR POSITION FOR THE REFUSE DISPOSAL DIVISION IN THE WASTE MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT IN PROGRAM ELEMENT 75211 FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the Waste Management Department is initiating a wide variety of programs in order to meet various mandat d recycling goals; and

WHEREAS, within the Refuse Disposal Division, there exists programs which include a Materials Recovery Facility, Green Material, Woodwaste and Demolition Material recycling projects, and a composting facility; and

WHEREAS, an Assistant Deputy Director will aid the department in managing its resources and also will provide the administrative skills necessary to implement these projects; and

WHEREAS, it has been requested that the Assistant Deputy

Director be exempted from the classified service; and

WHEREAS, section 117(a)17 of the Charter provides that
"managerial employees having significant responsibilities for
formulating or administering departmental policies and programs"
may be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance upon

first having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission reviewed this request on September 6, 1990 and has commented favorably upon the exemption as meeting the criteria set forth in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the annual appropriation ordinance to effectuate said reclassification; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City
Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably
by the Civil Service Commission in its memorandum to the City
Council, dated September 7, 1990, attached hereto as Attachment
A, Assistant Deputy Director position for the Refuse Disposal
Division in Waste Management (752) is hereby exempted from the
classified service and declared to be in the unclassified service
of The City of San Diego.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. O-17667 (NEW SERIES), as amended entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1991-92 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-17667-1, as adopted and amended therein, by amending the personnel authorization schedule for Waste Management (752) to reflect therein the Assistant Deputy Director position in Refuse Disposal, Program Element 75211 as being in the unclassified service.

Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for the above unclassified position created in sections 1 and 2 hereof, the salary rate set forth in Salary Rates 07.3, 07.4, 07.5 and 07.6 of the Table of Classifications and Standard Salary Rates under Managerial Category B, contained in Exhibit C to Ordinance No. 0-17648 (NEW SERIES), be and the same is hereby adopted.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage after two (2) public hearings pursuant to the authority contained in sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.

Exemption of an Assistant Deputy Director Position in the Waste

Management Department from the Classified Service

On September 6, 1990, the Civil Service Commission reviewed a request from the Waste Management Department to exempt an Assistant Deputy Director position in the Refuse Disposal Division from the Classified Service.

Charter Section 117 states that the Unclassified Service shall include "Managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council."

Upon review of the duties and responsibilities performed, the Commission finds that this position meets the criteria of the Charter and supports exemption from the Classified Service. If additional information would be of assistance in your consideration of this matter, staff is available to respond with details as necessary.
