AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 3, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING THE RULES OF THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION BY AMENDING SECTION 23.1103 [RULE X, SECTION 3] RELATING TO ANNUAL LEAVE.

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission, at its meeting of June 20, 1991, approved changes to Civil Service Rule X, Section 3, relating to maximum accrual of annual leave; and

WHEREAS, these changes were discussed with employee organizations during the meet and confer process and agreed upon between the parties; and

WHEREAS, the negotiated change allows an increase in the maximum accrual limit from 600 to 700 hours for employees who have completed 15 or more years of service or are eligible for management benefits; and

WHEREAS, the change also deletes the reference to maximum accrual limits in the Rules and instead indicates that the limit will be determined by the Civil Service Commission as provided in the Personal Manual; and

WHEREAS, this action will permit any future negotiated changes to be implemented immediately by action of the Civil Service Commission and is therefore recommended for adoption by the Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 3, of the San Diego
Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending the
Rules of the Civil Service Commission by amending Section 23.1103
[Rule X, Section 3] to read as follows:

SEC. 23.1103 ANNUAL LEAVE [Rule X, Section 3 of the Rules of the Civil Service Commission]

The intent of annual leave is to provide compensation to employees who are absent from duty because of illness, injury, death in the family, medical or dental care appointments, or personal business, or who utilize the time off as personal vacation.

- (1) FULL-TIME ACTIVE SERVICE. A full-time eligible employee shall be entitled to an annual leave with full pay as follows:
 - (a) Seventeen workdays each fifty-two weeks, credited biweekly, during the first through fifth years of active service.
 - (b) Twenty-two workdays each fifty-two weeks, credited biweekly, during the sixth through fifteenth year of active service.

- designated by the Commission
 and the Council as eligible for
 the Management Bonus Plan shall
 be entitled to twenty-two
 workdays, credited biweekly,
 each fifty-two weeks, during
 the first through fifteenth
 years of active service.
- (d) Twenty-seven workdays each fifty-two weeks, credited biweekly, during the sixteenth and succeeding years of active service.
- (e) and (f) No change.
- (g) Employees may accumulate annual leave credits up to the maximum determined by the Civil Service commission as provided in the Personnel Manual.
- (2) through (5) No change.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
