AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III, ARTICLE 3, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 33.3302 RELATING TO PEEP SHOW ESTABLISHMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 3, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 33.302 to read as follows:

SECTION 33.3302 - DEFINITIONS

No change in subsections (a), (b), (d) and (e).

(c) "Peep booth" means any room, both partial enclosure or partitioned area of any room, in which a peep show device is located. It does not include a mini-motion picture theater which is an establishment with seating capacity of more than five (5) but less than fifty (50) persons where still or motion images are regularly shown to an audience of more than five (5) but less than fifty (50) persons at any one time.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
