ORDINANCE NUMBER O-17688 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON SEP 23 1991

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 4, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 101.0460, INSTITUTIONAL OVERLAY ZONE, TO PROVIDE THAT THE SECTION SHALL NOT BE APPLICABLE TO PROPERTY OWNED BY SCHOOL OR COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICTS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 4, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 101.0460, to read as follows:

SEC. 101.0460 INSTITUTIONAL OVERLAY ZONE

A. [No change.]

B. APPLICATION OF THE INSTITUTIONAL OVERLAY ZONE

After a public hearing conducted pursuant to Chapter X, Article 1, Division 2 of the Municipal code, and upon evaluating the public health, safety, general welfare and sound zoning practice, the Institutional Overlay Zone may be applied to property if designated for institutional purposes on an adopted General Plan, community plan, or specific plan provided such land is owned by a governmental agency, other than a school or community college district.

C. INSTITUTIONAL USES

1. Institutional uses including but not limited to:

a. Hospitals and medical service organizations.

b. Government owned and operated offices, public safety facilities and libraries.

c. Park and recreational areas.

d. Cultural and community centers.

e. Museums.

f. Golf courses.



Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage, however, the provisions of this ordinance shall not be applicable within the Coastal Zone until the thirtieth day following the date the California Coastal Commission unconditionally certifies this ordinance as a local coastal program amendment. If this ordinance is not certified, or is certified with suggested modifications by the California Coastal Commission, the provisions of this ordinance shall be null and void within the Coastal Zone.
