ORDINANCE NUMBER O-17703 (NEW SERIES)

ADOPTED ON OCT 22 1991

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-17667 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1991-92 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION OF THE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT (441) TO EXEMPT A NEW DEPUTY DIRECTOR POSITION FOR THE LIFEGUARD SERVICES DIVISION (44700) FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the Lifeguard Services Division was created in fiscal year 1989, now consists of 103.24 position years and has been administered by a Marine Safety Captain; and

WHEREAS, that position has been responsible for day-to-day administration of the division, responsible for developing, directing and coordinating divisional and departmental policies in addition to other managerial functions; and

WHEREAS, it is requested that the position be appropriately classified as Deputy Director for Park and Recreation Lifeguard Services to properly reflect the managerial aspects of the job, in lieu of the Marine Safety Captain; and

WHEREAS, it has also been requested that the Deputy Director be exempted from the classified service; and

WHEREAS, section 117(a)17 of the Charter provides that "managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs" may be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance upon

first having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission reviewed this request on September 5, 1991 and has commented favorably upon the exemption as meeting the criteria set forth in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the annual appropriation ordinance to effectuate said reclassification; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably by the Civil Service Commission in its memorandum to the City Council, dated September 9, 1991, attached hereto as Attachment A, the Deputy Director position for the Lifeguard Services Division in the Park and Recreation Department (44700) is hereby exempted from the classified service and declared to be in the unclassified service of The City of San Diego.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. O-17667 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1991-92 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-17667-1, as adopted and amended therein, by amending the personnel authorization schedule for the Park and Recreation Department (441) to reflect therein the Deputy Director position in Lifeguard Services as being in the unclassified service, said


unclassified position to be in lieu of one (1) Marine Safety Captain.

Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for the above unclassified position created in sections 1 and 2 hereof, the salary rate set forth in Salary Rates 07.7, 07.8, and 07.9 of the Table of Classifications and Standard Salary Rates under Managerial Category C, contained in Exhibit C to Ordinance No. O-17648 (New Series), be and the same is hereby adopted.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption after two public hearings, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.



On September 5, 1991, the Civil Service Commission reviewed a request from the Park and Recreation Department to exempt a Deputy Director position in the Lifeguard Services Division from the Classified Service.

Charter Section 117 states that the Unclassified Service shall include "managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating and administering department policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempt from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council."

Upon review of the managerial duties and responsibilities performed, the Commission finds that this position meets the criteria of the Charter exemption from the Classified Service. If additional information would be of assistance in your consideration of this matter, staff is available to respond with details as necessary.
