AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 6,
OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING
SECTION 26.13, TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE
ADVISORY BOARD ON WOMEN TO THE COMMISSION ON
THE STATUS OF WOMEN.

WHEREAS, the Advisory Board on the Status of Women was established by Ordinance No. O-10987 (New Series), dated February 1, 1973 and was incorporated into the San Diego Municipal Code as section 26.13; and

WHEREAS, section 26.13 was amended on July 20, 1977 by Ordinance No. 12109 (New Series) to increase the number of members and change the name to "Advisory Board on Women;" and

WHEREAS, the Board has voted unanimously to request Council to change the name to the "Commission on the Status of Women" in order to conform with similar advisory groups around the country; and

WHEREAS, the matter is submitted for necessary amendatory action by the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 6, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending section 26.13 to read as follows:

SEC. 26.13 COMMISSION ON THE STATUS OF WOMEN

A. PURPOSE AND INTENT

It is the purpose and intent of the City Council to establish a Commission on the Status of Women as an advisory board to advise the Mayor, City Council and other agencies of City government of the needs and problems of women in the San Diego area and to recommend programs designed to alleviate any inequities that may confront women in social, economic and vocational pursuits.

B. COMMISSION ON THE STATUS OF WOMEN, ESTABLISHMENT AND COMPOSITION

There is hereby created a Commission on the Status of Women which shall consist of eleven (11) members of women who shall serve without compensation. The members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. The members shall serve two-year terms and each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and qualified. The members shall be appointed in such manner that the terms of not more than six (6) members shall expire in any year. The expiration date of all terms shall be March 1. During March of each year, the Mayor may designate one (1) member as chairperson; however, in the absence of such designation, the Commission shall, on or after April 15, selected from among their members a chairperson. Any vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired term of the member whose place become vacant. The Commission

shall adopt such rules, regulations and organizational structure for the conduct of its business as it may deem necessary. The Commission shall meet at least annually.

C. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS


The Commission shall:

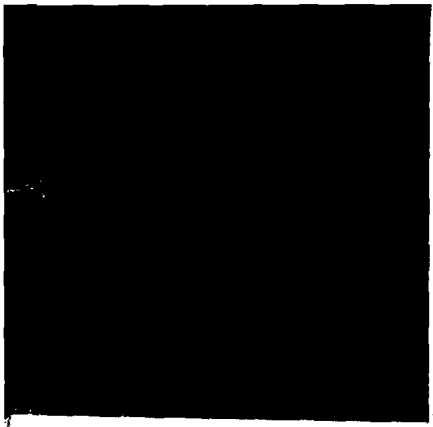
