

ORDINANCE NUMBER O-17710 (NEW SERIES)  
ADOPTED ON NOV 12 1991

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND EXTENDING INTERIM ZONING ORDINANCE NUMBER O-17562 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED DECEMBER 10, 1990, AND AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NUMBER O-17621 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED MARCH 18, 1991, AFFECTING THE NORTH CITY FUTURE URBANIZING AREA.

WHEREAS, the North City Future Urbanizing area is presently experiencing substantial pressures for private and public development; and

WHEREAS, the North City Future Urbanizing area is known to contain substantial and significant environmental resources which may be threatened by these proposed developments; and

WHEREAS, the North City Future Urbanizing area does not have an adopted community or other plan to appropriately guide development within this area; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department is in the process of preparing a framework plan for the North City Future Urbanizing Area; and

WHEREAS, premature development of the North City Future Urbanizing Area may inhibit full implementation of the framework plan once it is adopted; and

WHEREAS, the implementation of the framework plan in the North City Future Urbanizing Area is in the interest of the public safety, health and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has taken steps to select a

planning consultant who will prepare the framework plan; and

WHEREAS, Section 101.0203.1 of the San Diego Municipal Code provides that, pending the study and recommendation of zoning restrictions in an area of land within the City, the Council may adopt as a measure in the interest of public safety, health and welfare, a temporary interim zoning ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Council may extend the temporary interim zoning ordinance for one year upon recommendation of the Planning Commission; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that Ordinance Number O-17562 (New Series), adopted on December 10, 1990, as amended by Ordinance Number O-17621 (New Series), adopted March 18, 1991, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. No private or public development application requiring discretionary approval by the City Council, Planning Commission, Subdivision Board, Planning Director, or any other City official shall be approved until the Council adopts a framework plan for the North City Future Urbanizing Area delineating planning subareas, major open space and transit corridors, and generalized land use. The Environmental Tier, based upon an adequate inventory, mapping and analysis of the environmental resources within the area, shall be adopted as a component of the framework plan.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall not apply to modifications or additions to an existing veterinary



clinic and veterinary hospital or single-family dwelling unit or the construction, modification or addition to an accessory structure, on a preexisting recorded lot in separate ownership prior to April 17, 1991, provided, however, that the application for such development was submitted prior to November 19, 1990.

Section 3. That this interim zoning ordinance shall be of no further force and effect after the above listed event has occurred or September 22, 1992, whichever occurs first.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-17648 (NEW SERIES) AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR FISCAL YEAR 1991-92" TO CREATE A NEW POSITION OF ASSISTANT TO THE POLICE CHIEF; EXEMPTING SAID NEW POSITION FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; AMENDING EXHIBIT "C" TO SAID ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE THE NEW POSITION IN MANAGERIAL CATEGORY B; AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

This ordinance amends Ordinance No. O-17648 (New Series), the annual salary ordinance for fiscal year 1991-92, to create and establish a new class entitled "Assistant to the Police Chief," exempt said new class from the classified service and incorporates it in Exhibit "C" to the salary ordinance. This ordinance also places the new class in Managerial Category B and establishes the salary range at 07.3, 07.4, 07.5, and 07.56.
