AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 0-17648 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR FISCAL YEAR 1991-92" TO CREATE A NEW POSITION OF ASSISTANT TO THE POLICE CHIEF; EXEMPTING SAID NEW POSITION FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE; AMENDING EXHIBIT "C" TO SAID ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE THE NEW POSITION IN MANAGERIAL CATEGORY B; AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, an internal organizational audit of the Police
Department which was recently conducted recommended a
reorganization which would change considerably the duties of the
Police Chief; and

WHEREAS, many tasks which the Chief personally attended to will now be carried out by managerial staff; and

WHEREAS, to effectively accomplish those tasks, it is deemed necessary to increase the level of responsibility and scope of assignment of the presently designated "Adjutant to the Chief" position by reclassifying the position to Assistant to the Police Chief; and

WHEREAS, this reclassified position will function as the Chief's primary advisor and aide and thus be a key managerial employee; and

WHEREAS, on September 5, 1991, the Civil Service Commission reviewed the request from the Police Department to create this

position and exempt it from the classified service; and

WHEREAS, the Commission determined that the position meets the criteria of the City Charter for exemption and commented favorably upon the request; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the annual salary ordinance and create said position if Council should deem it appropriate and establish a rate of compensation therefor; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. O-17648 (NEW SERIES), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1991-92" be and the same is hereby further amended by creating and establishing the position of Assistant to the Police Chief.

Section 2. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably by the Civil Service Commission on September 5, 1991 as meeting the Charter criteria for exemption from the classified service, and after having considered and reviewed the report thereon from the Civil Service Commission, attached hereto as Attachment A, the Council deems exemption appropriate and the position created in section 1 above be and the same is hereby exempted from the classified service and declared to be in the unclassified service of The City of San Diego.

Section 3. That said Ordinance No. O-17648 (New Series), be and it is hereby further amended to amend Exhibit C thereto so as to reflect said position designation of Assistant to the Police Chief in Managerial Category B.

Section 4. As a schedule of compensation for the position established and enumerated in sections 1 and 2 above, the position of Assistant to the Police Chief is hereby authorized and at salary ranges of 07.3, 07.4, 07.5, and 07.6.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
