## SEC. 23.1205 APPEAL OF REMOVAL

- Conduct of Hearing. With the fulfillment by the employee of the above appeal procedure, the Commission shall fix a time and place for a public hearing.
- The Commission, at its discretion, may appoint one or more of its members to hear the appeal and submit findings of fact and a decision to the Commission. Based on the findings of fact, the Commission may affirm, modify, or overturn the decision in accordance with the provisions of section 23.1205(d).

## SEC. 23.1207 APPEAL OF SUSPENSION

The procedures and rights for any employee in the classified service appealing a suspension shall be the same as those prescribed in the rules relating to removal of an employee who has attained permanent status.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
