AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 3,
DIVISION 20, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE
BY AMENDING SECTION 103.2005 RELATING TO THE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 3, Division 20, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 103.2005, to read as follows:

**SEC. 103.2005 USE CLASSIFICATIONS FOR THE MARINA
PLANNED DISTRICT**

The following nonresidential uses are permitted in the Marina Planned District for that portion of the area designated twenty percent (20%) nonresidential:

The following uses may be considered by conditional use permit if determined to be compatible with the adjoining residential use:

a. through j. [No change.]


k. Residential Care Facilities.

On the property legally described as Lots "C" through "L" of Block 27, New San Diego Addition, according to the Map thereof No. 456, made by Gray and Johns, on file in the office of the County Recorder of San Diego County, residential care facilities may be permitted by conditional use permit.


