RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL BOND ELECTION HELD IN THE SAN DIEGO OPEN SPACE PARK FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 1 ON NOVEMBER 6, 1990.

WHEREAS, a special municipal bond election was held in the San Diego Open Space Park Facilities District No. 1 on Tuesday, November 6, 1990, pursuant to the provisions of Resolution No. R-276376, adopted August 7, 1990, which Special Municipal Bond Election was called for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the district the question of incurring a bonded indebtedness thereof to provide funds for the acquisition of open space and other park facilities as follows:


