RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 277232

ADOPTED ON JAN 09 1991

WHEREAS, the California Department of Water Resources, Division of Local Assistance, Urban Streams Restoration Program has announced the availability of funds for grants; and

WHEREAS, said grants are intended to help solve flooding and erosion problems in a way that provides environmental enhancement; and

WHEREAS, erosion in a feeder gully into San Clemente Creek has undermined an existing trail, affecting public access and safety; and

WHEREAS, the Marian Bear Natural Park Recreation Council has proposed to co-sponsor a grant application with City of San Diego for the purpose of funding a bank stabilization project in Marian R. Bear Memorial Park; and

WHEREAS, the project proposed for funding with the grant funds would be environmentally beneficial and categorically exempt from requirements for environmental document preparation under the following exemption: Class 7; and

WHEREAS, the prospects of receiving such a grant are reasonable likely and should be pursued; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Council approves the submission of a joint application with the Marian Bear Natural Park Recreation Council for an Urban Streams Restoration grant.

2. That the City Manager or his representative be and he is hereby authorized to submit an application to secure a California Department of Water Resources Urban Stream Restoration Grant for a bank stabilization project in Marian R. Bear Memorial Park.

3. That the City Manager or his representative is authorized to perform all necessary acts to accept the grant, when approved, and develop a work plan for the project including execution of any and all documents.

4. That the City Auditor and Comptroller be and is hereby authorized to submit invoices to the Department of Water Resources for activities carried out under the work plan for the grant project.

5. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to establish special interest earning funds in accordance with grant requirements.

6. That the project be and it is hereby certified as environmentally beneficial and categorically exempt from requirements for environmental document preparation under Class 7, CEQA Guidelines, section 15307.
