WHEREAS, the California Department of Water Resources,
Division of Local Assistance, Urban Streams Restoration Program
has announced the availability of funds for grants; and

WHEREAS, said grants are intended to help solve flooding and erosion problems in a way that provides environmental enhancement; and

WHEREAS, erosion control projects remain uncompleted in the Tecolote Canyon National Park; and

WHEREAS, a comprehensive watershed erosion study has identified this site as a high priority need based on the severity of erosion and siltation; and

WHEREAS, the Tecolote Canyon Citizen's Advisory Committee and the Friends of Tecolote Canyon have proposed to cosponsor a grant application with City of San Diego for the purpose of providing funds to complete the erosion control projects; and

WHEREAS, the project proposed for funding with the grant funds would be environmentally beneficial and categorically exempt from requirements for environmental document preparation pursuant to the adopted Addendum to Negative Declaration No. 86-0187; and

WHEREAS, we consider the prospects of receiving such a grant to be reasonable likely and should be pursued; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the City Council approves the submission of a joint application with the Friends of Tecolote Canyon and the Tecolote Canyon Citizen's Committee for an Urban Streams Restoration grant.
- 2. That the City Manager or his representative be and he is hereby authorized to submit an application to secure a California Department of Water Resources Urban Stream Restoration Grant for an erosion control project in Tecolote Canyon Natural Park.
- 3. That the City Manager or his representative is authorized to accept the grant and perform all necessary acts to develop a work plan for the project, including execution of any and all documents.
- 4. That the City Auditor and Comptroller be and is hereby authorized to submit invoices to the Department of Water Resources for activities carried out under the work plan for the grant project.
- 5. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to establish special interest earning funds in accordance with grant requirements.
- 6. That the project be and it is hereby certified as environmentally beneficial and exempt from further environmental document preparation in that an Environmental Mitigated Negative

Declaration has been prepared as File No. 86-0187 and adopted by Council Resolution No. R-269335.
