WHEREAS, although the month long celebrations include many artistic and educational programs, it is also a time to remember the continued need for a wide range of social service programs including community based programs and to salute those community based organizations that continually address the concerns of the community which range from drug use and associated violence, the lack of employment, support for working mothers and fathers in the form of childcare and to continue as a City to work toward supporting these programs; and

WHEREAS, many groups and leaders in the African-American Community are working together and are to be saluted for their efforts to bring attention to these issues; and


