EXHIBIT A

MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM

The applicant has agreed to a Transportation Systems Management (TSM) Program to address the Land Use (Development Intensity) and Traffic issue. The following mitigating measures will be incorporated into the project:

- 1. The applicant shall implement the TSM Program.
- 2. To measure the effectiveness of each TSM element as it is implemented, peak hour manual traffic counts at all SAIC parking access points shall be gathered. The initial data gathering effort shall be three months after implementing the measure and reported to the Deputy Director, Engineering and Development Department, Transportation Demand Management Division.
- 3. The applicant shall appoint a TSM coordinator immediately upon City approval of the TSM.
- 4. The applicant shall provide update reports of the effectiveness of the TSM Program to the Deputy Director, Engineering and Development Department, Transportation Demand Management Division, On October 1 of each year. A copy of the reports shall be forwarded to the Environmental Analysis Section.
- 5. The Deputy Director, Engineering and Development Department, Transportation Demand Management Division, shall be responsible for monitoring and enforcing the Transportation Systems Management Program for the project.
