RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 277722

ADOPTED ON APR 22 1991

WHEREAS, the purpose of organizing a "National Youth Service Day" is to reinforce in our young Americans the importance and excitement of helping others and in creating a public awareness of the positive contributions that young people make in the nation's progress; and to link their talents and resources to address some of the major issues facing our cities -- drug and alcohol abuse, education, hunger and homelessness and assisting our elderly citizens; and

WHEREAS, the co-sponsors of the National Youth Service Day are the United States Conference of Mayors, the Jefferson Awards, Youth Service America, Weekly Reader and Campus Outreach Opportunities League; and

WHEREAS, with the assistance of United Way's Students Actively Volunteering for You (S.A.V.Y.) and the School Districts of San Diego County, San Diego is sponsoring its own Youth Service Day Event honoring those students from each high school who best exemplify community service; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that Tuesday, April 23, 1991 be and is hereby declared to be "Youth Service Day" in San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all area youth are encouraged to become more involved in their cities and help to build a bright tomorrow.
