

WHEREAS, the Civil Rights Act of 1991 (H.R.1) seeks to "restore and strengthen civil rights laws that ban discrimination in employment;" NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That this City Council hereby supports the Civil Rights Act of 1991 (H.R.1) for the reasons set forth in the Department of Legislative Services Report No. 91-27, dated May 8, 1991.



2. That this City Council hereby directs the City's Washington, D.C. legislative advocates to express this support to appropriate members of Congress and the President.
