RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 277953

WHEREAS, Section 8330, et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code provides a procedure for the summary vacation of streets and public service easements by City Council resolution where the portion of street to be vacated is excess to the City's right-of-way needs and is not longer required for street and highway purposes; and

WHEREAS, in connection with said vacation, the City desires to reserve a certain easement; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners have requested the vacation of an excess portion of Hawthorn Street east of Jacot Lane, adjacent to Lots 12 and 13, Block 132 of Choate's Addition, Map No. 351, to facilitate development of their property; and

WHEREAS, the portion of street to be vacated is not needed for present or prospective public street purposes; and

WHEREAS, there is no present or prospective use for the street either for the public street system, for which the right-of-way was originally acquired, or for any other public use of a like nature that can be anticipated in that the right-of-way is not needed for public street, bikeway or open space purposes; and

WHEREAS, those properties adjoining the street to be vacated will continue to have access; and

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WHEREAS, the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and

WHEREAS, the vacation or abandonment is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; and

WHEREAS, the public street system for which the right-ofway was originally acquired will not be detrimentally affected by this vacation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That an excess portion of Hawthorn Street east of Jacot Lane, adjacent to Lots 12 and 13, Block 132 of Choate's Addition, Map No. 351, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 17647-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-277953-1, which is by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby ordered vacated.
- 2. That The City of San Diego hereby reserves and excepts the right, easement, and privilege of placing, constructing, repairing, replacing, maintaining, using, and operating public utilities of any kind or nature, including, but not limited to, sewer facilities and all necessary and proper fixtures and equipment for use in connection therewith, through, over, under, upon, along, and across the hereinafter-described easement, together with the right of ingress thereto and egress therefrom, together with the right to maintain the said easement free and clear of any excavation or fills, the erection or construction of any building or other structures, the planting of any tree or

trees thereon, together with the right to otherwise protect from all hazards the operation and use of any right hereby reserved.

- 3. That the easement reserved herein is in, under, over, upon, along, and across that portion of Hawthorn Street and that the easement is more particularly shown and delineated on Drawing No. 17647-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- $\frac{277953-1}{1}$.
- 4. This resolution shall be and become effective upon receipt by the City from the owner of the subject property of a building restricted easement deed as agreed upon by owner during public testimony, which deed shall contain the following language:

We hereby grant and relinquish to the City of San Diego, a municipal corporation, any and all right to construct, erect, or maintain any aboveground, roofed building or covered structure over, upon, or across all those portions of Lot 12 and Lot 13 of Map No. 351, as shown on Drawing No. 17647-B, and designated "Building Restricted Easement Granted Hereon," reserving to the owner of the fee underlying said easement herein granted the continued use of said real property for any purpose, except as herein provided, and the right to grant easements to any public utility company for distribution facilities, provided the same are installed underground. Responsibility for maintenance of said lands shall remain with the owner of the fee title of said land, and nothing contained

herein shall be construed to assign any maintenance responsibility to the City of San Diego, nor shall anything contained herein be construed to confer any rights to the general public.

Grantor agrees that the easement area shall in no event be used in calculating the allowable building area for said lots. This easement shall be binding on Grantor and successors in interest, and shall run with the land, and shall only be extinguished by act of the City Council, and shall be recorded.

Grantor agrees that no additional residential units may be constructed as a result of the increased lot size due to the street vacation which involved a public street which was previously located in the area of this building restricted easement and which was the subject of City Council Resolution No. R-277953, adopted May 20, 1991. The setbacks as established prior to the said street vacation will continue to remain in effect and shall not change location as a result of said street vacation.

- 5. In the event no such building restricted easement deed is received within one hundred and eight (180) days following the date of adoption of this resolution, this resolution shall be and become void and of no further force or effect.
- 6. That the City Engineer shall advise the City Clerk of the receipt of the aforemention building restricted easement deed and that the City Clerk shall then cause a certified copy of this

resolution, with drawing, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.

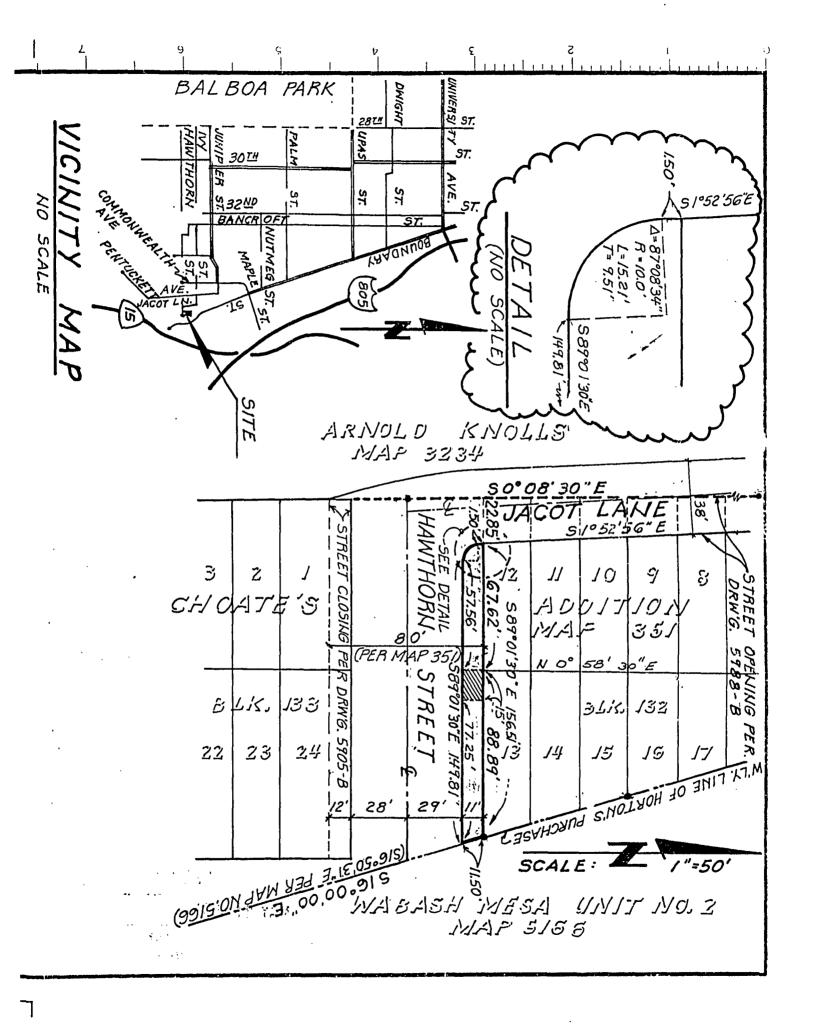
