BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby recognize the accomplishments and contributions of Dusty Rhodes and thank his friends and family for their kind gift to the people of San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Saturday, August 24, 1991, be and the same is hereby designated as "Dusty Rhodes Community Park Day" in San Diego.
