PLANNING - \$50 per reinspection visit

FIRE DEPARTMENT - \$40 per reinspection visit

GENERAL SERVICES - \$40 per reinspection visit

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a late fee in the amount of 10% of the total reinspection fee owed is hereby authorized to be charged to any person who fails to pay a reinspection fee by the required deadline for payment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to Ordinance 0- 17694 the fees so established by this resolution may be revised by the Manager and Planning Director, as necessary, to reflect current costs of reinspections in accordance with Council Policy and that this resolution shall become effective upon the effective date of said ordinance.
