RESOLUTION NUMBER R-278672 ADOPTED ON SEP 2 3 1991

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego continues to face the increasingly difficult task of financing essential and desired services; and

WHEREAS, the City must strive to become more efficient, effective, and innovative in its operation; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager in his Report No. 91-406, dated 9-18-91, proposes that the City meet these requirements by establishing an Entrepreneurial Program; and

WHEREAS, the intent of this program would be to provide a means by which the City can venture into new revenue-producing projects for the purpose of providing additional services to the City's citizens, employees, and visitors while generating additional sources of revenue to fund other City services; and

WHEREAS, the City should encourage and reward intelligent and prudent risk-taking while also developing mutually beneficial public-private partnerships; and

WHEREAS, ultimately the Entrepreneurial Program may develop into a potential funding source for department-suggested projects that would serve the public while generating new or additional City revenues; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager proposes the establishment of a City Store as the initial Entrepreneurial Program project; and

WHEREAS, the primary goals for the proposed City Store are:

- 1. To establish a new City revenue source.
- 2. To establish an additional means of disposing of unique surplus or salvaged City materials such as old parking meters, signs, and other items of public interest.
- 3. To establish a public-private partnership to sell merchandise with the City's logos to its employees, citizens, and tourists to promote a display of pride in San Diego.
- 4. To promote and capitalize on the public's appreciation of City-owned assets such as Balboa Park and Mission Bay through the development of related promotional merchandise.
- 5. To provide a pilot project for the Entrepreneurial Program; and

WHEREAS, the details of the City Store's proposed operation are set forth in the City Manager's Report No. 91-406; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approves the concept of the Entrepreneurial Program and its pilot project, the City Store, to the extent the program and pilot project are permitted by law; and

WHEREAS, the initial set up cost for the Entrepreneurial Program's pilot project is one hundred thousand (\$100,000) dollars, which amount has been identified in the Special Promotional Program budget; and

WHEREAS, these funds were previously encumbered for the Air Space America pending litigation; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that these funds may be released and reallocated at this time; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council that the City Manager is authorized to establish a City Store as a pilot project for the Entrepreneurial Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized to issue a Request for Proposal ("RFP") for solicitation of firms interested in participating in the project, which RFP is on file as Attachment B to City Manager's Report No. 9-406.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized to evaluate the proposals received in response to the RFP and negotiate contracts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is directed to forward the negotiated contracts to the Council for approval.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to establish an Entrepreneurial Program Enterprise Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council appropriates one hundred thousand (\$100,000) dollars from the Transient Occupancy Tax Fund Special Promotional Program from the funds previously encumbered for Air Space America pending litigation (10224/916/680).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to transfer the one hundred thousand (\$100,000) dollar Special Promotional Program allocation to the Entrepreneurial Program Enterprise Fund for the funding of the start up costs of the City Store.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the expenditure of all monies deposited into the Entrepreneurial Enterprise Fund be made in accordance with its operating budget (which is attached as Exhibit A to City Manager's Report No. 9-406), Council approved projects, and for the purposes for which the Fund was established.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the interest earnings generated by the Enterprise Fund are authorized to be retained and added to the Entrepreneurial Program Enterprise Fund's revenues.
