WHEREAS, the City Council of San Diego recognizes that domestic violence is a problem of major proportions in San Diego, with over 17,000 incident reports filed with law enforcement agencies in 1990; and

WHEREAS, San Diego City law enforcement, homeless programs, the military, and social services are significantly impacted by spouse abuse; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of all San Diego residents to encourage the optimum utilization and coordination of available resources for service delivery; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor's Domestic Violence Council for San Diego is formed of military, public, and private service providers for the purpose of working toward the establishment of a coordinated, integrated system-wide response to domestic violence through inter-agency information exchange, analysis of current response and support for appropriate enhancements; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, hereby proclaims October 7, 1991 to be the "MAYOR'S DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COUNCIL FOR SAN DIEGO DAY" in San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Council declares its support of the purpose and goals of the Domestic Violence Council toward the reduction and prevention of domestic violence.
