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WHEREAS, the provisions of Council Policy No. 600-15 require that a noticed public hearing be conducted before the City Council prior to the vacation of a City street; and WHEREAS, Section 66499.20½ of the California Government Code provides that the filing of the map shall constitute abandonment of all streets and easements not shown on said map; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners have requested the vacation of a portion of Pendleton Street and a portion of Law Street, in connection with Westview II (TM 90-0576) to facilitate development of their property; and

WHEREAS, in connection with said vacation, the City desires to reserve certain easements; and

WHEREAS, there is no present or prospective use for the streets either for the public street system, for which the rights-of-way were originally acquired, or for any other public use of a like nature that can be anticipated in that the rights-of-way are not needed for public street, bikeway, or open space purposes; and

WHEREAS, those properties adjoining the streets to be vacated will continue to have access; and

WHEREAS, the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and

WHEREAS, the vacation or abandonment is not inconsistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; and


WHEREAS, the public street system for which the right-ofway was originally acquired will not be detrimentally affected by this vacation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That a portion of Pendleton Street and a portion of Law street, in connection with Westview II (TM 90-0576), as more particularly shown on Exhibit "A," on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-278809, which is by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, be and the same are hereby ordered vacated.
- That The City of San Diego hereby reserves and excepts 2. the right, easement, and privilege of placing, constructing, repairing, replacing, maintaining, using, and operating public utilities of any kind or nature, including, but not limited to, general utilities and all necessary and proper fixtures and equipment for use in connection therewith, through, over, under, upon, along, and across the hereinafter-described easement, together with the right of ingress thereto and egress therefrom, together with the right to maintain the said easement free and clear of any excavation or fills, the erection or construction of any building or other structures, the planting of any tree or trees thereon, together with the right to otherwise protect from all hazards the operation and use of any right hereby reserved. Upon acquisition of encroachment permit from the City Engineer pursuant to the Municipal Code of the City, the owners' underlying fee may utilize the above-described parcel of land for

structures, the planting or growing of trees, or the installation of privately owned pipelines.

- 3. That The City of San Diego hereby reserves and excepts the right, from vacation and abandonment, easements, and rights of any public utility pursuant to any existing franchise or renewals thereof, at any time, or from time to time, to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew, and enlarge overhead or underground lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles, and other structures, equipment, and fixtures for the transportation and distribution of electrical or electronic energy and natural gas, and for incidental purposes including access to protect the property from all hazards in, upon, over, and across the above-described portions of streets to be vacated and abandoned.
- 4. That the easement reserved herein is in, under, over, upon, along, and across Pendleton Street and Law Street and that the easement is more particularly shown and delineated on Exhibit "A," on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-278809-1
- 5. That the resolution shall not become effective unless and until the final map for Westview II has been approved by Council action. In the event that the final map is not approved within the time allowance specified under the tentative map conditions or any subsequent time extensions allowed, this resolution shall become void and of no further force or effect.
- 6. That the City Engineer shall advise the City Clerk of the completion of the aforementioned final map, and the City




Clerk shall then cause a certified copy of this resolution, with drawing, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.
