WHEREAS, the recently passed State Clean Air Act requires local governments to implement strategies to comply with its air quality standards; and

WHEREAS, one very important option available for improving the air quality of the San Diego region is increased mass transit service levels along this I-15 corridor; and

WHEREAS, this resolution directs the City Manager to place the northern I-15 corridor on an equal level of priority with other areas in the City regarding the planning, development and funding of mass transit; and

WHEREAS, in order for the City to communicate its position to those organizations responsible for acquiring the funding and providing the transit services, this resolution will request the City's representatives to the SANDAG Board of Directors and the Metropolitan Transit Development Board to include the planning, development and funding of increased mass transit in the northern I-15 corridor as a priority in future Transportation Improvement Plans; NOW, THEREFORE,
