A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AND DENOMINATED AS THE MISSION GORGE ROAD (GREENBRIER AVENUE TO PRINCESS VIEW DRIVE) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. R-278912, a public hearing was called for on <u>DEC 031991</u> at the hour of <u>DEC 031991</u> a

From the easterly lot line to 25 feet west and from the northerly lot line to 530 feet south of the northerly lot line of lot 1 of Mission Valley Village No. 2, Map No. 6315; lot 1 of Pepper Tree Condominiums, Map No. 9237; Portion of lot 1 of Rosenberg Subdivision Map No. 8254; Portions of lots 53 and 63 of Rancho Mission Referees Partition, Map No. 330; Portions of lots 3-7, 14, 15 and 16 and Parcels A-C of Rancho Mission of San Diego, part of lots 61, 62 and portion of 63, Map No. 1550; lots 2188-2197 of Allied Gardens

Unit No. 10, Map No. 3439; portion of lot 7 of Mission Valley Industrial Park Unit No. 2, Map No. 5321; portion of lot 10 of Mission Valley Industrial Park Unit No. 4, Map No. 7554.

Said district shall also include the following described public rights-of-way:

MISSION GORGE ROAD between 100 feet north of the northerly line of Greenbrier Avenue and the southeasterly boundary of Tierrasanta Boulevard/
Princess View Drive; OLD CLIFFS ROAD from the westerly line of Mission Gorge Road to a line parallel to and 300 feet west of the westerly line of Mission Gorge Road.

all as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 26256-1-2-D entitled "MISSION GORGE ROAD (GREENBRIER AVENUE TO PRINCESS VIEW DRIVE) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT," copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-278912 and attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given by the City Clerk to all affected property owners as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and the utilities concerned in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The City Council does hereby find and determine that the public health, safety and general welfare require the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within the area set forth above and that pursuant to Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the above-described area is hereby declared to be an underground utility district in the City of San Diego, and the maps and document referred to above are hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution.
- 2. The City Council shall by subsequent resolution fix the date upon which the property in the district must be ready to receive underground service, and shall by subsequent resolution order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service.
- 3. The City Clerk be and he is hereby instructed to notify all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and all affected utility companies of the adoption of this resolution within fifteen (15) days after the date of such adoption. The City Clerk shall further notify said affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code

of the necessity that if they desire to continue to receive electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service they shall provide at their own expense all necessary facility changes on their premises so as to receive underground service from the lines relocated underground of the supplying utility company subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility company on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California (as of the date of adoption of this resolution) and subject to all other applicable requirements of State law and City ordinances. The Clerk's notification shall be made in the manner provided in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code.




