AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER IV, ARTICLE 1, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY CREATING AND ENTITLING DIVISION 7 TO READ ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH PERMITS, BY RENUMBERING SECTION 41.07 TO READ SECTION 41.0701, AND RENUMBERING AND AMENDING SECTIONS 41.07.1 AND 41.07.4 TO SECTIONS 41.0702 AND 41.0703, RESPECTIVELY, ALL RELATING TO PENALTIES FOR HEALTH SERVICE PERMIT FEE DELINOUENCIES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter IV, Article 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code is amended by creating and entitling Division 7, Environmental Health Permits, by renumbering section 41.07 to read section 41.0701, and by renumbering and amending sections 41.07.1 and 41.07.4 to sections 41.0702 and 41.0703, respectively, to read as follows:

DIVISION 7

Environmental Health Permits

SEC. 41.0701 Health Permit Fees Paid to County

[No change in text.]

SEC. 41.0702 - Health Permit Fees - General - Annual Inspection Fee

Except as otherwise specifically provided in this chapter, every person applying for a permit under the provisions of this chapter shall at the time of making

application for such permit pay a fee, the exact amount of which shall be determined by the County of San Diego and kept on record by the County Department of Health Services and on file in the City Clerk's Composite Rate Book. In any case where the applicant has failed to file the application and obtain the required permit, license or registration as determined by the County of San Diego, there shall be added to and collected with the required fee a penalty. The penalty shall be determined by the County of San Diego and kept on record by the County Department of Health Services and on file in the City Clerk's Composite Rate Book. The imposition or payment of the penalty imposed by this section shall not prohibit the imposition of any other penalty prescribed by this chapter or a criminal prosecution for violation of this chapter. Institutions exempt from real property assessments and taxation are exempt from paying the fees established by this section.

Every person applying for a permit under the provisions of this chapter shall at the time of making application for the permit pay a fee for the following:

SEC. 41.0703 Renewal of Health Permit, Penalty for Delinquency

A permit issued pursuant to this division shall expire on the last day of the month of the one year anniversary month in which the permit was issued and shall be renewed annually with the exception that the fee for food vending and sewage pumping vehicles and for food vending machines shall be prorated so that the annual renewal date will be January 1 of each year. The fee for vehicles and vending machines that are prorated shall be reduced by an amount equal to 1/12 of the total annual permit fee for each month less than one year for which the permit At the time application is made, is issued. there shall be paid to the Department of Health Services the required annual fee, which fee is due and payable each year. The annual fee, if unpaid by the last day of the month following the month in which the permit expires is thirty (30) days delinquent, and on the first day of the next following month, if still unpaid, is sixty (60) days delinquent.

If the annual fee is not paid the first month after it is due, there shall be added

to and collected with the annual fee, an additional penalty to be determined by the County of San Diego and kept on record by the County Department of Health Services and on file in the City Clerk's Composite Rate Book. The imposition of or payment of the penalty imposed by this section shall not prohibit the imposition of any other penalty prescribed by this code, or prosecution for violation of this code.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

SEC. 41.07 41.0701 Health Permit Fees Paid to County

SEC. 41.07.1 41.0702 Health Permit Fees - General - Annual Inspection Fee

Except as otherwise specifically provided in this chapter, every person

applying for a permit under the provisions of this chapter shall at the time of making application for such permit pay a fee, the exact amount of which shall be determined by the County of San Diego and kept on record by the County Department of Health Services and on file in the City Clerk's Composite Rate Book. In any case where the applicant has failed for a period of thirty (30) days to file the application and obtain the required permit, license or registration as determined by the County of San Diego, there shall be added to and collected with the required fee a penalty. equal to 10% of the fee and for each-additional-month-or-fraction-of-a-month after the expiration of said 30-day period that the applicant fails to file such application and obtain such permit, license or registration, there shall be added to and collected with the fee an additional penalty equal to 10% of the fee; provided, however, in no event shall the total penalty added to the fee pursuant to this section be more than 60% of the fee. The penalty shall be determined by the County of San Diego and kept on record by the County Department of Health Services and on file in the City Clerk's Composite Rate Book. The imposition

or payment of the penalty imposed by this section shall not prohibit the imposition of any other penalty prescribed by this chapter or a criminal prosecution for violation of this chapter. SEC. 41.07.4 41.0703 Renewal of Health Permit, Ten Percent (10%) Penalty for Delinquency

A permit issued pursuant to this chapter division shall expire on the last day of the month of the one year anniversary month in which the permit was issued and shall be renewed annually with the exception that the fee for food vending and sewage pumping vehicles and for food vending machines shall be pro-rated prorated so that the annual renewal date will be January 1 of each year. The fee for vehicles and vending machines that are pro-rated prorated shall be reduced by an amount equal to 1/12 of the total annual permit fee for each month less than

one year for which the permit is issued. At the time application is made, there shall be paid to the Department of Health Services the required annual fee, which fee is due and payable each year. The annual fee, if unpaid is delinquent on the first day of the second month after the month in which the permit expires. by the last day of the month following the month in which the permit expires is thirty (30) days delinquent, and on the first day of the next following month, if still unpaid, is sixty (60) days delinquent.

If the annual fee and penalty is not paid the first month after it is due, there shall be added to and collected with the annual fee, an additional penalty equal to ten percent (10%) of the annual fee for each month or fraction of a month during which the annual fee or penalty continues to remain unpaid; provided, however, in no event shall the total penalty added to the fee pursuant to this section be more than sixty percent (60%) of the annual fee: to be determined by the County of San Diego and kept on record by the County Department of Health Services and on file in the City Clerk's Composite Rate Book. The imposition of or payment of the

penalty imposed by this section shall not prohibit the imposition of any other penalty prescribed by this chapter code, or prosecution for violation of this chapter code.

READ SECTION 41.0701, AND RENUMBERING AND AMENDING SECTIONS 41.07.1, AND 41.07.4 TO SECTIONS 41.0702 AND 41.07.0, RESPECTIVELY, ALL RELATING TO PENALTIES FOR HEALTH SERVICE PERMIT FEE DELINGUENCIES.

Over the years, the City Council has adopted County Health Department permit fees by referencing the County Code. However, for cost recovery purposes, the County has annually reviewed and revised the penalties for various delinquencies on submitting permit fees. Because there is currently, a difference between the County and City regarding penalties on delinquent health permit fees, this necessitates that the San Diego Municipal Code ("SDMC") be amended as well.

By amending SDMC sections 41.07 and 41.0704 as referenced in this document, the City will no longer need to provide revisions to coincide with County amendments. The proposed SDMC revision outlines that "there shall be added to and collected with the required fee a penalty to be determined by the County of San Diego and kept on record by the County Department of Health Services and on file in the City Clerk's Composite Rate Book." The proposed amendments to the SDMC mirror the language in the County Code.
