AN ORDINANCE CALLING A MUNICIPAL PRIMARY
ELECTION IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON TUESDAY,
JUNE 2, 1992.

WHEREAS, Section 10 of the Charter of The City of San Diego provides that commencing with the year 1984 the elections to the offices of Mayor and City Attorney shall be held every four (4) years, and that the Municipal Primary Election for these offices shall be held on the same date in each election year as the California State Primary Election; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on FEB 24 1992, 1992, the City Council of The City of San Diego adopted Resolution No. R- 279440, requesting the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego to order the consolidation of the Municipal Primary Election to be held on June 2, 1992, with the Statewide Primary Election to be held on the same date; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordered that a Municipal Primary Election will be held in the City of San Diego on Tuesday, June 2, 1992, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the following offices:

MAYOR	four-year term
CITY ATTORNEY	four-year term

Section 3. The polls for said elections shall be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, June 2, 1992.
