ADOPTED ON APR 07 1992

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-17667 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1991-92 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION OF THE CITY MANAGER'S OFFICE (040) TO EXEMPT A NEW ASSISTANT TO THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR POSITION FOR THE HUMAN RELATIONS COMMISSION (601) FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE, AND ESTABLISHING A SALARY RATE THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the Associate Administrative Analyst position in the Human Relations Commission is responsible for providing administrative support and technical assistance to the Commission, and developing and implementing policies related to the Commission's programs; and

WHEREAS, it is requested that the position be appropriately classified as Assistant to the Executive Director to properly reflect the managerial aspects of the job; and

WHEREAS, it is also requested that the Assistant to the Executive Director be exempted from the classified service; and

WHEREAS, section 117(a)17 of the Charter provides that "managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs" may be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance upon first having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, a review of the position indicates the nature and

duties of said position is consistent with the unclassified criteria set forth in Charter section 117(a)17; and  
and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service commission reviewed this request on February 6, 1992, and has commented favorably upon the exemption as meeting the criteria set forth in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the annual appropriation ordinance to effectuate said reclassification; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon favorably by the Civil Service Commission in its memorandum to the City Council, dated February 14, 1992, attached hereto as Attachment A, the Assistant to the Executive Director of the Human Relations Commission (601) is hereby exempted from the classified service and declared to be in the unclassified service.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. O-17667 (NEW SERIES), as amended entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1991-92 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by amending Document No. OO-17667-1, as adopted and amended therein, by amending within the personnel authorization schedule of the City Manager's Office (040) for the Human Relations Commission (601) to reflect therein the Assistant

to the Executive Director position as being in the unclassified service.

Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for the above unclassified position created in sections 1 and 2 hereof, the salary rate set forth in Salary Rates 07.3, 07.4, 07.5, and 07.6 of the Table of Classifications and Standard Salary Rates under Managerial Category B, contained in Exhibit C to Ordinance No. O-17667 (NEW SERIES), be and the same is hereby adopted.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage after two (2) public hearings pursuant to the authority contained in sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.

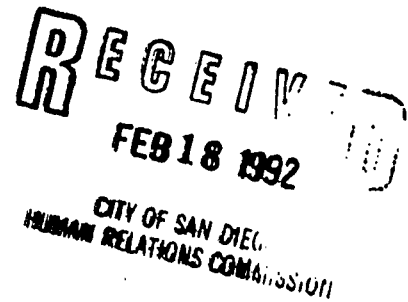

SUBJECT: Exemption of an Assistant to Executive Director of the Human Relations Commission




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On February 6, 1992, the Civil Service Commission reviewed a request from the City Manager's Office to exempt a new Assistant to the Executive Director position from the Classified Service. This position will assist the Executive Director of the Human Relations Commission in providing administrative support and technical assistance to the Commission, and in developing and implementing policies related to the Commission's programs.

Charter Section 117 states that the Unclassified Service shall include "managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating and administering department policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempt from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council."

Upon review of the administrative and managerial duties and responsibilities of this position, the Commission finds that this position meets the intent of Charter Section 117. If additional information would be of assistance in your consideration of this matter, staff is available to respond with details as necessary.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 4, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE By amending SECTION 101.0448 RELATING TO THE AIRPORT OVERLAY ZONE.  
This ordinance amends the airport approach overlay zone ordinance of the City. It establishes a 50' vertical setback from the established aviation route for the approach to Lindbergh Field. Notwithstanding this ordinance, persons will be allowed to construct buildings 40' above the existing ground level.
