AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 4, DIVISION 1, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 24.0103, RELATING TO THE CITY EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Employees' Retirement System ("CERS") administers the retirement program on behalf of employees of the Unified Port District ("UPD") under terms of an agreement between the City and the UPD entered into on February 11, 1964, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-667149 ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to this Agreement, all employees of the UPD are classified as general members of CERS; and

WHEREAS, the UPD has met and conferred with the Harbor Police Officers' Association, and both parties have agreed that certain employees in classifications represented by the association be classified as safety members of CERS; and

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to pay the necessary actuarial costs associated with this change; and

WHEREAS, an election was held among the affected employees of the UPD on January 10, 1992, that resulted in a Vote of 101 in favor of the change and 1 opposed; and

WHEREAS, the results of this election were certified and approved by the Board of Administration ("Board") for CERS on January 24, 1992; and

WHEREAS, changes must be made in the Agreement between the City and the UPD to provide for appropriate employees being classified as safety members of CERS; and

WHEREAS, the changes required in the Agreement have been set forth in the First Amendment to the Agreement, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. $RR-\ 279991$: and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has been authorized and empowered to execute the above-referenced First Amendment to Agreement pursuant to Resolution No. R-279991 adopted on MAY 26 1992; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Municipal Code does not provide for Harbor Police Officers in the definition of Safety Member; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary and appropriate to amend the Municipal Code to include Harbor Police Officers within the definition of Safety Member; and

WHEREAS, the Section of the Municipal Code reflecting this change has been reviewed and approved by the Board; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 4, Division 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 24.0103, to read as follows:

SEC. 24.0103 Definitions

- a. through f.(1) [No change.]
- f.(2) "Safety member" means any person who is
 either a sworn officer of the Police Department of The

City of San Diego employed since July 1, 1946, a uniformed member of the Fire Department of The City of San Diego employed since July 1, 1946, or a full-time employed lifeguard of The City of San Diego, or a full-time police officer of the Unified Port District who is a peace officer under Penal Code Section 830.1(a); provided, however, that Police Cadets, persons sworn for limited purposes only, and all other members of the Police and Fire Departments and lifeguard service shall not be considered safety members for the purpose of this article.

f.(3) through u. [No change.]

Section 2. No member in the classification of UPD Harbor Police Officer shall be entitled to safety member status or benefits prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
