ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 17785 (NEW SERIES) ADOPTED ON JUN 2 2 1992

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 101.0101.20; AND BY ADDING SECTION 101.0101.76.1 RELATING TO REGULATIONS AFFECTING PROPERTY WITHIN SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL ZONES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 101.0101.20, to read as follows:

SEC. 101.0101.20 Family

The term "family" means two or more persons who are related through blood, marriage, legal adoption, or joined through a judicial order of placement or guardianship.

When used as an adjective to describe the occupants of a residential dwelling, or as an adjective to describe a type of residential dwelling, the term "family" is synonymous with the term "single housekeeping unit."

Section 2. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and the same is hereby amended by adding Section 101.0101.76.1, to read as follows:

SEC. 101.0101.76.1 Single Housekeeping Unit

The term "single housekeeping unit" refers to the status of the occupants of a residential dwelling unit and means one person, or, two or more persons who reside

together, jointly occupy and have equal access to all areas of a dwelling unit and who function together as an integrated economic unit for a period of occupancy which exceeds one month.

Single housekeeping unit status shall not apply to the occupants of a sorority or fraternity, motel, hotel, boarding or lodging home, or any facility that is required to be licensed by a public agency.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage, however, the provisions of this ordinance shall not be applicable within the Coastal Zone until the thirtieth day following the date the California Coastal Commission unconditionally certifies this ordinance as a local coastal program amendment. If this ordinance is not certified, or is certified with suggested modifications by the California Coastal Commission, the provisions of this ordinance shall be null and void within the Coastal Zone.
