AN ORDINANCE REMOVING THE INSTITUTIONAL OVERLAY ZONES (IOZ) FROM ALL SCHOOL SITES WITHIN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, AS DEFINED BY SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 101.0460, AND AMENDING ORDINANCES NO. O-17372 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED OCTOBER 16, 1989; NO. O-17281 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED APRIL 17, 1989; NO. O-17207 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED JANUARY 9, 1989; NO. O-17016 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED JANUARY 25, 1988; NO. O-17134 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED SEPTEMBER 6, 1988; NO. O-17654 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED JUNE 10, 1991; NO. BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That all school sites (as set forth in Table 1 attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference) located within the City of San Diego, California, within the boundaries of the districts designated "IOZ" on C-Sheets No. C-848 (Pages 1-20), filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 17788, be, and they are hereby amended by removing the IOZ zone as such zone is described and defined by San Diego Municipal Code section 101.0460.

Section 2. That Ordinances No. O-17372 (New Series), adopted October 16, 1989; No. O-17281 (New Series), adopted April 17, 1989; No. O-17207 (New Series), adopted January 9,

1989; No. O-17016 (New Series), adopted January 25, 1988; No. O-17134 (New Series), adopted September 6, 1988; No. O-17654 (New Series), adopted June 10, 1991; No. O-16993 (New Series), adopted December 7, 1987; No. O-17088 (New Series), adopted May 9, 1988; No. O-17060 (New Series), adopted April 18, 1988; and No. O-16994 (New Series), adopted December 7, 1987, of the ordinances of The City of San Diego be and they are amended insofar as the same conflict herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage, however, the provisions of this ordinance shall not be applicable within the Coastal Zone until the thirtieth day following the date the California Coastal Commission unconditionally certifies this ordinance as a local coastal program amendment. If this ordinance is not certified, or is certified with suggested modifications by the California Coastal Commission, the provisions of this ordinance shall be null and void within the Coastal Zone.

Section 4. In areas of the City of San Diego other than the Coastal Zone no permits for development inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be issued unless application therefore was made prior to the date of adoption of this ordinance.

Section 5. Within the Coastal Zone no permits for development inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be issued unless application therefore was made prior to
