
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 1, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 101.0101.55 RELATING TO TRANSIT CORRIDORS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 101.0101.55, to read as follows:

SEC. 101.0101.55 TRANSIT CORRIDORS AND NODES

- A. "Transit Corridor" means the area located within one-quarter-mile of public streets identified in Map No. C-846 on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00- 4 20 (or its successor maps) as having the location, mix of densities, mix of uses and development patterns that can generate sufficient bus ridership to support a frequent and consistent level of bus service (as typified by a 10- and 15-minute frequency of service).
- B. "Nodal Corridor" means the same thing as a transit corridor but with the additional qualification of being within two miles (approximately eight minutes by bus) of a transit node that is located directly adjacent to a transit corridor.

- C. "Transfer Node" means the area within onequarter-mile radius of existing and proposed major bus transfer centers. Proposed transfer nodes are those centers that have been approved for development by Metropolitan Transit Development Board (MTDB) with identified funding available.
- D. "Transit Node" means the area within onequarter-mile radius of existing and proposed trolley stops. Proposed trolley stops are those stops that have been approved for development by the Metropolitan Transit Development Board (MTDB) with identified funding available.
- E. "Transit Hub" means any area greater than one square mile with an aggregate density of transit nodes averaging more than five transit nodes per square mile.
- F. Planning Department staff shall update every two years, if necessary, the official transit map (presently Map No. C-846 and on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00-17836) that identifies the location of transit corridors, nodal corridors, transfer nodes, transit nodes and the transit hub, as defined in Municipal Code section 101.0101.55.

Section 2. The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply in the Coastal Zone, as delineated on a map filed with the City Clerk as Document No. 768548, until this ordinance is certified, as submitted as a Local Coastal Program amendment, by the California Coastal Commission.

Section 3. The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to any project for which a complete application had been submitted to the City prior to September 15, 1992.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
