AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 8, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 101.0835 RELATING TO MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL PARKING REGULATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 8, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 101.0835, to read as follows:

SEC. 101.0835 MULTI-FAMILY PARKING

- B. ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS. The provisions of Section 101.0835 shall apply to all multi-family development in residential and commercial zones and planned districts City-wide, excluding the Redevelopment Subdistrict of the Barrio Logan PDO, Centre City Overlay Zone, Centre City PDO, Gaslamp Quarter PDO, Marina PDO, Mission Beach PDO, La Jolla PDO and La Jolla Shores PDO. Special standards are, however, provided for those projects located within the Beach Parking Impact Area as shown on the Map Drawing C-731 (on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00-17069) within a Campus Parking Impact

area as shown on the Map Drawing No. 00-17343.1) and those projects owned and/or managed by the San Diego Housing Commission as very-low income projects. These requirements shall also apply to all multi-family developments processed with a discretionary permit. The Planning Director may increase or decrease the parking requirements for discretionary projects to meet specific community plan objectives.

All new construction shall be provided with a minimum of permanently maintained off-street parking spaces in a parking area or private garage on the same prémises, as follows, and shall adhere in all respects to the other requirements of Municipal Code Chapter X, Article 1, Division 8.

This reduction may not be used in Campus Parking Impact Areas as shown on Map No. C-795 (on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00-17837). This reduction may be used in conjunction with shared parking as described in Municipal Code sections 101.0822 and 101.0830.

Section 3. The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to any project for which a complete application had been submitted to the City prior to the introduction of this ordinance by the City Council.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
